By virtue of a Monition to me directed and bearing with
shown unto you I Admounish you to set up or cause
to be set up a decent and convenient Hatch or Wicket
almost opposite to the South = door of the parish Church
of Bliffstable lying within the space of fifteen foot of
to some of the Churchyard there incumbered on you so
to set up and repair as owner of an Estate lying
within the parish of Bliffstable aforesaid all down farm
and also that you pay or cause to be paid unto John
Dowdall and Thomas Brook late Churchwardens of
Bliffstable aforesaid for their lawfull broker) the
sum of three hundred pound of lawfull money of Great Britain
(for the doing whereof you stand bounden by a
diffinitive Sentence in a Civill Consistory at Woll
in a Cause there depending between the said late
Churchwardens on the one part and you the said Rob:
Stone on the other part) at or before the nineteenth
day of this instant June Otherwise I Oke you
to appear at the aforesaid Consistory Court in the
Cathedral Church of Woll on Sunday the six and
twentieth day of June aforesaid between the hour of
nine and eleven in the forenoon to see yourself
Excommunicated for your contumacy Dated the
sixth day of June Anno Domini 1711.
