

This Indenture made (on sealed six penny stamp parchment) the twentieth day of September in the tenth year of the
reign of our sovereign lord george the second by the grace of god of great britaine france and ireland king defender of the faith a
forte and in the year of our lord one thousand seven hundred and thirty six between Robert stone of Chipstable in the County of Somerset
man of the one part and John stone of Chipstable aforesaid yeeman of the other part witnesseth that the said Robert stone for and
consideration of the summe of five shillings in lawfull brittish mony to him in hand paid by the said John stone before the execution hereof & in
werte whereof is hereby acknowledged hath bargained and sold and by these presents to the said Robert stone John abargained and sold to
the said John stone all those his the said Robert stones three full fourth parts (the whole in four parts to be divided) of all that messuage or lands
and lands called or known by the name of Woodworthy and pinkhouse and also all that pice of woody ground or coppice called pinkwood
situate lying and being in the parish of Chipstable aforesaid and part and partall of the manor of Chipstable and now in the tenure or
occupation of the said Robert stone his assigns or assigned videtur naut or videtur nauts And also three full fourth parts (the whole in four parts
to be divided) of all offices buildings barns stables shippings outhouses courtlages & back sides orchards gardens yards inclosures pastures meadows
fields grounds common and common of pasture and village on Abdon Green and Ryball hill and all other commons and common of
pasture trees woods underwood ways paths passages waters waterourses profits commodities advantages hereditaments and appurtenances
whatsoever therunto belonging or in any wise appertaining or to or with the same commonly used occupied or enjoyed or reputed to
be known as part partall or member or parts partalls or members thereof and the reversion and reverions remainder and remain
ants issue and profits of all and singular the said premises and all the estates and estates right title interest claiming and demand
whatsoever of him the said Robert stone of me and to the same and every part and partall thereof to have and to hold the said
three full fourth parts (the whole in four parts to be divided) of the said several and respective messuages tenements coppice yards hereditaments
and premises parts and purparts thereof with their and every of their respective rights members and appurtenances hereby bargained and
sold or intituled so to be unto the said John stone his executors administrators and assigns from the day next before the day of the said
year of our lord during and unto the full end and termes of one whose year fully to be compleat and ended YE M D M C L V and paying
herefore at the end of the said term unto the said Robert stone his heires or assigns the rent of a peper leyn if the same shall lie
lawfully demanded to the intent that by virtus hereof and of the statute for transferring of leases into possession to the said John stone to
be in the actuall possession of all and singular the said premises and be thereby enabled to arrest and take a lyeant and a release of the
reversion and inheritance thereof to him and his heires forever In witness whereof the said parties to these presents their
hands and seals have hereunto interchangably set the day and year first above written.
