



This is the last will and Testament of me Joan Stone of the Parish of Glaston in the County of Somerset Widow made published and declared this thirtieth day of November in the Year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred ninety and five First I Give to my Daughter Thomazin Wife of Thomas Parratt all my Cloaths and wearing apparel Except one Gold Ring which I Give to my Daughter Joan Scott hereby declaring that it is not for want of affection or regard that I Give them no more but because they have already had a sufficient and suitable advancement and provision made for them I likewise Give unto my Daughter Thomazin Wife of Thomas Parratt the sum of Thirty shillings to be paid by my Executors in six Months after my decease All the rest and residue of my real personal and Testamentary Estate of what nature sort or kind whatsoever and wheresoever situate I Give devise and bequeath limet direct and appoint unto my Son Robert Stone his Heirs Executors Administrators and Assigns for ever And I hereby appoint him whole and sole Executor of this my last will and Testament which I do in Order to make him as much as possible upon a level with his Brothers and Sisters so provided for as aforesaid In Testimony whereof I have to this my will set my hand and Seal the day and Year first above written = Signed Sealed published and declared by the said Joan Stone the Testatrix as and to be her last will and Testament in the presence of us who in her presence and at her request and the presence of each other of us have set and subscribed our Names as Witnesses thereto =
