This is the last Will and Testament
of me Thomas Stone of Lydeard Saint Lawrence
in the County of Somerset Officer of Excise made this
third day of February in the year of our Lord one
thousand seven hundred and eighty five as
follows I give devise and bequeath unto my
dearly beloved wife All my messuages lands
tenements hereditaments and premises And all
my parts parturys shares and proportions of any ^{and}
messuages lands tenements hereditaments both
freehold and leasehold or otherwise whatsoever
whether in possession reversion remainder or
expectancy or otherwise howsoever and wheresoever
situate And all my estate right Title and
interest therein and thereto and also all my goods
chattels rights credits monies and securities for
money personal and testatory estate and
effects whatsoever and wheresoever To hold to
her use upon the trusts uses ends intents and

by the said Testator Thomas Stone as and to
be his last Will and Testament in the presence
of us who at his request and in his presence
and in the presence of each other have subscribed
our names as witnesses hereto
