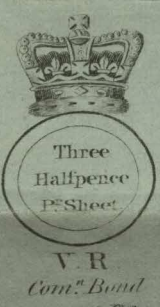

United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland  
Defender of the Faith &c. and in the Year of our Lord One  
Thousand Eight Hundred and fifty one

The Condition of this Obligation is such That if the above  
Bounden William Stone

Heirs Executors or Administrators  
shall and do well and truly pay or Cause to be paid unto the above  
named Robt Stone

Executors Administrators or Assigns the full Sum of eight  
Hundred pounds

of Good and lawful Money of Great Britain with Interest  
for the same at the rate of three and half  
per Cent. for the same on the 14 day of Decr  
next ensuing the date of these presents  
without fraud or further delay. Then this Obligation to be void and  
of none effect or else to remain in full force and Virtue.
